Just a few last minute updates and some refreshers regarding registration and lodging for this year’s ASA Annual Meeting which is being held at North Central College in Naperville, Illinois.

#### **PLEASE NOTE THIS CHANGE**

#### **LODGING CHECK-IN AT WARD HALL ONLY:**

Since Schneller does not have a lobby or good drop-off area, **all lodging check-in will be at Ward Hall.** Go to the Ward Information Desk to receive your access card and suite and room keys from the NCC staff. They can direct you to Schneller and to other campus buildings, give you a free parking pass, and answer questions you might have regarding the campus.

After you get settled in your room, please come to the ASA registration desk in the Wentz Concert Hall lobby to receive your name badge and meeting program. You will need your name badge or meal tickets if you are dining in the Kaufman Dining Center.

#### **Driving directions to Ward Hall – 192 E. Chicago Ave.** (address for front of building):

The **driveway to Ward Hall is in the back**, so from the intersection of Chicago Ave. and Brainard Street, turn south onto Brainard St. Follow frontage road past athletics complex, including Benedetti-Wehrli Stadium. After passing the Stadium, proceed to the right, up the hill to the circle drive. Ward Hall is the residence hall on your right.

**Ward Hall** is staffed by NCC from 8 AM to 10 PM daily. The Ward Information Desk phone number is 630.637.5846.

**Parking passes** are free and will be available to you at Ward Hall and at the ASA registration desk.

#### **LODGING CHECK-OUT AT WARD HALL and KEYS RETURN:**

Please leave your linens and towels in the room. **Return access card and suite and room keys to the NCC staff at Ward Information Desk** between the hours of **8 AM and 10 PM.**

Lost keys are \$50; access cards, \$20, immediately payable to NCC.

#### **AFTER HOURS CHECK-OUT and KEYS RETURN:**

If you need to check out between 10 PM and 8 AM, please let me know so arrangements can be made.

#### **ASA REGISTRATION:**

The ASA registration desk will be in the **Fine Arts Center (171 E. Chicago Avenue)** in the Wentz Concert Hall lobby (Thursday through Sunday) and in the Madden Theater lobby (Monday) except at meal times. Then we will be in the Kauffman Dining Center.

### NAME BADGES:

You will receive a name badge and program when you register. Please note that this badge is your **pass** into the various lectures and other activities of the conference.

### MEAL PASSES/TICKETS:

All meals, except for Sunday breakfast, will be served in the **Kaufman Dining Center** (#27, campus map). Sunday breakfast will be in the White Activities Center (#13, campus map). All meals **must** be purchased through the ASA since the dining center does not accept payment. If I have meal tickets available at Kaufman, I can accept only **cash**. Breakfast is \$10; lunch, \$15; dinner, \$18.

### NCC ACCOMODATIONS:

**Schneller Hall (all room numbers starting with S)** (#24, campus map): Air-conditioned, elevator. Most apartments are bi-level; some are on one level. Bedrooms on the first and third floors are on the lower level of the apartment. Bedrooms on the second and fourth floors are on the upper level of the apartment. However, each apartment can be accessed from both floors. Please enter your suite on the floor of your bedroom.

**Ward Hall (all room numbers starting with W)** (#33, campus map): Air-conditioned, elevator. All apartments are suite-style.

**Linen Package:** Includes 1 pillow, 2 bed sheets, 1 pillow case, 1 blanket, 1 bath towel, 1 hand towel, and 1 wash cloth. No extra linens or pillows are available. You will need to bring extra linens if you require them.

**For you to bring:** Plastic cup, soap, shampoo, toothpaste and other toiletries, clothes hangers.

**MEETING ROOMS:** (air conditioning set at 70°)

- **Fine Arts Center** (#31, campus map), Wentz Concert Hall, Madden Theater, Room 114, Room 138: Friday, Saturday, Sunday afternoon and evening, Monday
- **White Activities Center** (#13, campus map), Centennial Hall (3<sup>rd</sup> floor): Sunday morning

**INTERNET ACCESS:** Limited wireless internet access is available **only** in the Wentz Concert Hall lobby. There are WiFi hotspots within a few blocks where you can also get internet access.
